1. Multiple Team Meets:

Any contest involving more than two meets will be considered a multiple team meet. Officials for multiple meets will be paid the following fee: Two Minute matches \$48. One Minute matches \$45.

The first Dual Match an official works in a multiple meet will be paid at the above rate; all subsequent matches worked by the same official will be paid \$5.00 less than the above scale.

Number of officials recommended for multiple team tournaments are 1 official for each mat.

2. Elimination Tournaments:

The number of teams in an elimination tournament will be determined by the average number of wrestlers in each bracket of that tournament.

Officiating fees for elimination tournaments will be \$64.00 (for two minute rounds) and \$54 (for one minute rounds) times the number of teams entered.

Example:

16 team tournament = 16 x \$64.00 (Two Minute Rounds) = \$1,024.00

This total assessment will then be divided equally among the officials.

- (a) These fees apply to elimination tournaments with consolation wrestle backs from the semifinals.
- (b) Any other formats resulting in additional wrestling such as, but not limited to, double elimination type tournaments add \$55 per official.
- (c) If a tournament has two sessions (day and evening) where there is a complete break in the tournament, add \$19.00 per official.
- (d) If an elimination tournament runs for two days, add \$61 per official.
- (e) Number of officials recommended for elimination tournaments are as follows:
